The mandate of the team/committee is to provide administrative oversight and support to the respective committees and boards to ensure uniformity of ethical approval processes and procedures are adhered to across every faculty and department of the Narh Bitá College. The Narh Bitá College Ethics Committees are mandated to review proposed research involving human and non-human participants conducted by students, faculty and staff of the College in order to ensure adherence to both local and international guidelines. In carrying out their responsibilities, the committees ensure that the right, dignity, safety and general wellbeing of participants are protected. The committee follows a current standard institutionally supported Research Policy, Procedures, and Guidelines for Research Ethics. The Ethics and Research Committee Board is housed under the Narh Bitá College Research and Development (ONBCRD) Office on Tema main campus.
